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Introduction



Penderyn Distillery is a boutique whisky distillery located in Wales, in a small but historic village known as Penderyn. A group of friends conceived the idea of setting up the first whisky distillery in Wales in the late 1990s. The idea became a reality on 1 March 2004, in the presence of HRH Prince Charles.

Distilling in Wales was a lost art for centuries, but not anymore. With Penderyn pushing its frontiers, whisky from Wales is gaining an excellent reputation worldwide.

The distillery boasts of a few things which other distilleries do not have. One of their prized possessions is their single copper-pot stills. Dr David Faraday, a descendant of the famous Victorian scientist, Michael Faraday, designed the copper-pot stills. Penderyn produces whisky from the copper-pot still and yields a flavourful spirit of high strength and purity. The clean spirit comes with great complexity, depth and finesse that translate to the flavourful whiskies that Penderyn is famous for.

Penderyn distillery also received the coveted Grand Spirit Master from the Spirit Business Competition in 2017.

Products from Penderyn

Dragon Range

The Dragon range showcases the pride of Wales as the red dragon is the national flag. The Royal Welsh badge bears the motto 'Y ddraig goch ddyry cychwyn', which translates as 'The red dragon inspires action.'

1. Penderyn Legend – UP: \$105, DP:\$89.25



The Penderyn Legend features the house-style of the distillery. It is matured in fine American oak barrels and finished in Madeira wood.

Penderyn Legend is bottled at 41% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: Aromas of fresh apples and citrus fruits intermingle with cream fudge and sultana raisins to create a complex yet fresh, clean and well-balanced whisky.

Palate: Incredibly smooth and both fresh and rich dried fruits abound. Delicate and sweet on the palate with just a hint of bitterness to remain refreshing.

Finish: A long aftertaste of Madeira cake and sultanas.

2. Penderyn Myth – UP: \$115, DP: \$97.75



The Penderyn Myth is mysterious like its name. It is matured in a range of specially selected ex-red wine and ex-bourbon casks to infuse amazing flavours in the liquid.

Penderyn Myth is bottled at 41% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: Fresh and lively, Myth has mixed citrus fruits mingling with apple, pear drops and the merest hint of tropical fruits.

Palate: Sweetness dominates then moves over to allow some refreshing bitterness to emerge while the mixed fruits continue to dominate the flavours.

Finish: Gradually, all the flavours ebb away to leave memories of a lively and light style of whisky that is easy to drink.

3. Penderyn Celt – UP: \$120, DP: \$102



The Penderyn Celt is a peated whisky. It is matured in fine American oak barrels and then finish in ex-peated whisky quarter cask. The smaller casks give a higher percentage of interaction to the whisky, infusing the liquid with a light, peaty taste.

Penderyn Celt is bottled at 41% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: Mild aromas of peat smoke, early morning at the rocky seaside and warm marmalade on toast all compete for attention.

Palate: It begins with great sweetness before the smoky, slightly medicinal flavours descend.

Finish: Slightly tannic but leaves a long and lingering freshness in the mouth.

Gold Range

Penderyn's Gold range reflects the value and qualities of Welsh gold that was worn by legendary Welsh princes. Welsh gold is extremely rare to come by, and make into pure and precious jewellery for the Welsh princes. Penderyn's Gold range present Welsh gold to the world, in the form of their precious, pure whiskies.

1) Penderyn Madeira – UP: \$145, DP: \$123.25



The Penderyn Madeira is the original house-style whisky. It is aged in ex-bourbon barrels and finished in ex-Madeira wine casks. This expression brings the full character of Welsh gold in a sleek and stylish bottle.

Penderyn Madeira is bottled at 46% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: A classic freshness with aromas of cream toffee, rich fruit and raisins.

Palate: Crisp and finely rounded, with the sweetness to balance an appetising dryness.

Finish: Notes of tropical fruit, raisins and vanilla persist.

2. Penderyn Portwood – UP: \$199, DP: \$169.15



The Penderyn Portwood is a favourite among many Penderyn fans. It is aged in ex-bourbon barrels and finished in ex-port wine casks. This expression brings to mind of a rich, fruit cake with a dark chocolate base.

Penderyn Portwood is bottled at 46% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: Aromas of rich dried fruits with dark chocolate and cranberries. A hint of toasty oak mingles with baked nutty dryness.

Palate: A creamy richness with some honey and spiced notes emerging.

Finish: Smooth with a soft oak and honey sweetness lingering gently on the tongue.

3. Penderyn Sherrywood – UP: \$160, DP: \$136



The Penderyn Sherrywood uses only premium ex-Oloroso sherry casks and the finest American barrels. It is aged in ex-bourbon barrels and finished in ex-sherry casks. This expression is different from the typical sherried whisky because it holds bourbon-influenced notes too.

Penderyn Sherrywood is bottled at 46% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: Aromas of dark fruits and rich toffee mingle with green apples and hazelnuts to create a deep mystery of its origins.

Palate: Rich sweetness gives way to refreshing dryness as you drink.

Finish: Sweet notes of toffee and sultana persist in the long finish.

4. Penderyn Rich Oak – UP: \$165, DP: \$140.25



The Penderyn Rich Oak uses only premium ex-bourbon barrel from America. It is aged exclusively in ex-bourbon barrels before getting a finished in ex-red wine casks. This expression is an extended cask finish as our Master Distiller wants to make sure that all the rich red wine flavours are drawn into the whisky to create a very well-balanced single malt.

Penderyn Rich Oak is bottled at 46% abv.

Tasting notes:

Nose: Vanilla cream, toffee, green apples, banana, mango and guava mingle with a cinnamon spice in the background

Palate: A medley of sweetness from vanilla cream, toffee, tropical fruits and apples comes layer by layer. Rich and complex, the creamy texture also offers hints of oak, cinnamon and nutty toffee.

Finish: Long and sweet with vanilla cream and cinnamon lingering all the way.

You can pay through your credit cards through PayPal, but please note that we will have to charge you extra 3% for it.
- 3) Once we verify the mode of payment, we will forward you an invoice for the order, and we would need your cooperation to pay for the invoice within 3 working days and inform us with the payment slip.
